This annual review has catered for this demand since its foundation, by the late Harold Barnes, more than 30 years ago. Its objectives are to consider, annually, basic areas of marine research, returning to them when appropriate in future volumes to deal with subjects of special and topical importance and to add new ones as they arise. The 34th volume continues to regard the marine sciences, with all their various aspects, as a unity. Physical, chemical and biological aspects of marine science are dealt with by experts actively engaged in their own field.
